Document "Quality Moments" Under Societal Level of BASICS: (Those times when you witnessed that "spark of life" in the resident)

For example: Henry was kidding and laughing with the other male residents during the Big Band Group held last night. He told stories about hearing the Army Band at West Point football games. "I'm an Army man, myself." This is the first time Henry joined the group and said he would like to come again.

Meeting the care plan goal that Henry will actively take part in an activity he enjoys 1x per week x next 4 weeks.
