This is to advise you that CNS Discontinuance Codes E82 and E83 (Emergency Medical Care for Aliens) will be disabled from MA CNS Discontinuance codes. They will become part of acceptances (open/close) when CNS goes to that phase. In the interim, when applicable, districts should use the manual notice - DSS-3622, "Notice of Decision on Your Medical Assistance Application" and check the box which indicates, "Accept for emergency medical care and services only for (Names) from _____ to _____." The manual attachment DSS-3622A, "Notice of Eligibility for Coverage for the Treatment of an Emergency Medical Condition" should accompany the DSS-3622.

This production migration will remove selected pending notices from the database after completion of the WMS Batch Update process on Friday, March 22, 1996. As with previous migrations, a report (CNS-00920) will be generated listing the cases that are affected.
