# Tier 1 CBO Engagement

Narrative description of current and future plans for contracting with Tier 1 CBOs.

<b>PPS Nam :</b>	Adirondack Health Institute
<p>AHI PPS is committed to building a fully Integrated Delivery System in our region and we recognize the role Tier 1 CBOs will play in that system. AHI PPS has included these organizations in our contracting and funds flow plans. As of 12/31/2016, Tier 1 CBOs account for over 25% of the partners in the AHI PPS network, and over \$625,000 in funds have flowed directly to these organizations.</p> <p>In addition to funds flow to Tier 1 CBOs, AHI PPS has provided additional resources to these vital partners. AHI PPS provided resources to Tier 1 CBOs such as providing data, conference attendance, and training participation. For example, AHI PPS hosted a “Bridges out of Poverty” training series at eight locations throughout the PPS region to assist employers, community organizations, social service agencies, and individuals reduce poverty in a comprehensive way. The Bridges out of Poverty program seeks to improve job retention rates, build resources, improve outcomes, and support those individuals who are moving out of poverty and therefore has a strong correlation with the Medicaid and uninsured populations. At least 48 Tier 1 CBO partners were among the participants in The Bridges out of Poverty series that trained 225 individuals with an additional 31 individuals trained as Bridges out of Poverty trainers.</p> <p>As of 12/31/2016, AHI PPS has not tracked second level funds flow to any partner organization, but now that a mechanism is in place to track this type of funds flow we will explore utilizing this method in future quarters. AHI PPS has provided second level additional resources to Tier 1 CBOs, primarily in the form of trainings such as youth and adult mental health first aid, safe talks, and suicide prevention and response.</p> <p>Furthermore, AHI manages other programs outside of the work we do within the PPS that has a large cross-over with the PPS partners and the Medicaid population. Our Population Health Improvement Program (PHIP) convenes stakeholders throughout the region to identify regional health priorities and advance efforts to improve community health. Approximately 80% of the attendees at 2016 stakeholder meetings were from Tier 1 CBOs. In September 2016 AHI hosted a summit on “Innovative Approaches to Rural Health Care” and featured NYS Medicaid Director Jason Helgeson as the keynote speaker. The AHI Summit was attended by nearly 200 people, approximately 30% of whom were affiliated with Tier 1 CBOs.</p> <p>The level of Tier 1 CBO participation within the AHI PPS network and funds flow and additional resources provided to these organizations will continue to grow in DY2Q4 and throughout the term of the DSRIP program.</p>
