ACO Medicare Shared Savings	Beneficiaries agree to the sharing of their PHI when they enroll, unless they sign the "Declining to Share Personal Health Information" form. This form restricts Medicare from sharing PHI for care coordination and quality improvement. The documents are examples of similar forms used by different ACOs.
