### Pre-Validation Services

Individual and group providers may utilize the pre-validation services offered by NY Medicaid EHR Incentive Program Support if they already know the following information that they intend to submit with their attestation:

- 90-day reporting period
- Medicaid encounter data
- Total patient encounter data

### **DEADLINE REMINDERS**

For Payment Year 2015, Eligible Professionals in MU Stage 2 must register for Public Health Objectives by March 1, 2015.

Attestations for Payment Year 2014 are still being accepted. The deadline for Eligible Professionals is March 31, 2015.
