Payment Year 2020 Pre-Validation Period Dates

Pre-Validations involve submitting Medicaid Patient Volume information prior to the payment year opening for validation. This can help providers avoid patient volume remediation during the attestation process, and can allow them to be approved for payment sooner.

Pre-Validations for PY2020 will be accepted from September 14, 2020 to December 14, 2020.

If you would like to take advantage of this service to avoid patient volume remediation during the official or soft opening attestation periods, please begin the process of finding a suitable Medicaid patient volume reporting period. More information on how to submit a Pre-Validation will be made available as the request period draws closer.

Please Note: Pre-Validations submitted before the official request period begins will not be considered. All submissions received before this time must be re-submitted during the Pre-Validation Period for a review to occur.
