### MURPH Contact Change Request Forms

If the contact person for your Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) account has left your organization and you can no longer access the registration, our support team can help. Please fill out the [MURPH Contact Change Request Form](#) and send it to [MUPublicHealthHelp@health.ny.gov](mailto:MUPublicHealthHelp@health.ny.gov) for review. Upon receipt, we will update the contact information for your registration in the MURPH system, which will allow the new contacts to access the registration and make any necessary changes, or view the Audit Report Card.

As a reminder, all changes to MURPH registrations must be complete by **July 31st, 2021**. No changes will be captured in the Audit Report Card for the practice after this time. Because there is a slight processing delay when any Contact Change Request Form is received, we ask that all forms be submitted by **July 23rd, 2021** if you wish to make changes prior to the deadline. There is no guarantee that forms received after this date will be processed in time for the new contact to make changes to the registration.
