The NY Medicaid EHR Incentive Program is officially closing tomorrow, **December 31st, 2021**. Our Support Team services will be reduced, and the phone line for the program will be disconnected. The only email inbox that will be active after this cut off date will be hit@health.ny.gov. LISTSERV communication emails will end after this message.

Additionally, the MEIPASS and MURPH systems will no longer be functional as of January 1st, 2022. Because of this, we encourage you to download any needed information from these systems prior to **11:59PM tomorrow evening**.

Audit Report Card Download Reminder

Following the close of the Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) system, your Audit Report Card will serve as the main source of proof for your engagement status with any registries housed in this system. We encourage all Registration and Alternate contacts to download the Audit Report Cards for their organization in the MURPH system by Friday, December 31, 2021.

These email notifications are provided as a free service to subscribers and the notifications will contain information on the Medicare and Medicaid EHR Incentive Programs.
