EHR Incentive Program Public Health Reporting Objective

New Registry Available for Eligible Professionals Outside the 5 Boroughs of NYC

The NYS Department of Health (NYSDOH) is now collecting syndromic surveillance data from Eligible Professionals (EPs) working at licensed urgent care centers outside the five boroughs of NYC. EPs who work in an urgent care center are encouraged to update their registration of intent to say "yes" they intend to submit electronic syndromic surveillance data to the NYSDOH in the Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System.

Active engagement with the [NYSDOH](#) to submit syndromic surveillance data can count as meeting the syndromic surveillance reporting measure for the EHR Incentive Program. Please see

Providers Should Review and Update their Registrations of Intent for 2017

As 2017 begins, we would highly encourage all providers to review their registration of intent for the Public Health Reporting Objective and to make any necessary updates or changes. The registration of intent is completed on the Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System, which is hosted on the NYSDOH [Health Commerce System \(HCS\)](#). Please note that only one registration is required to be submitted and providers should update their registration, rather than submitting a new one.
