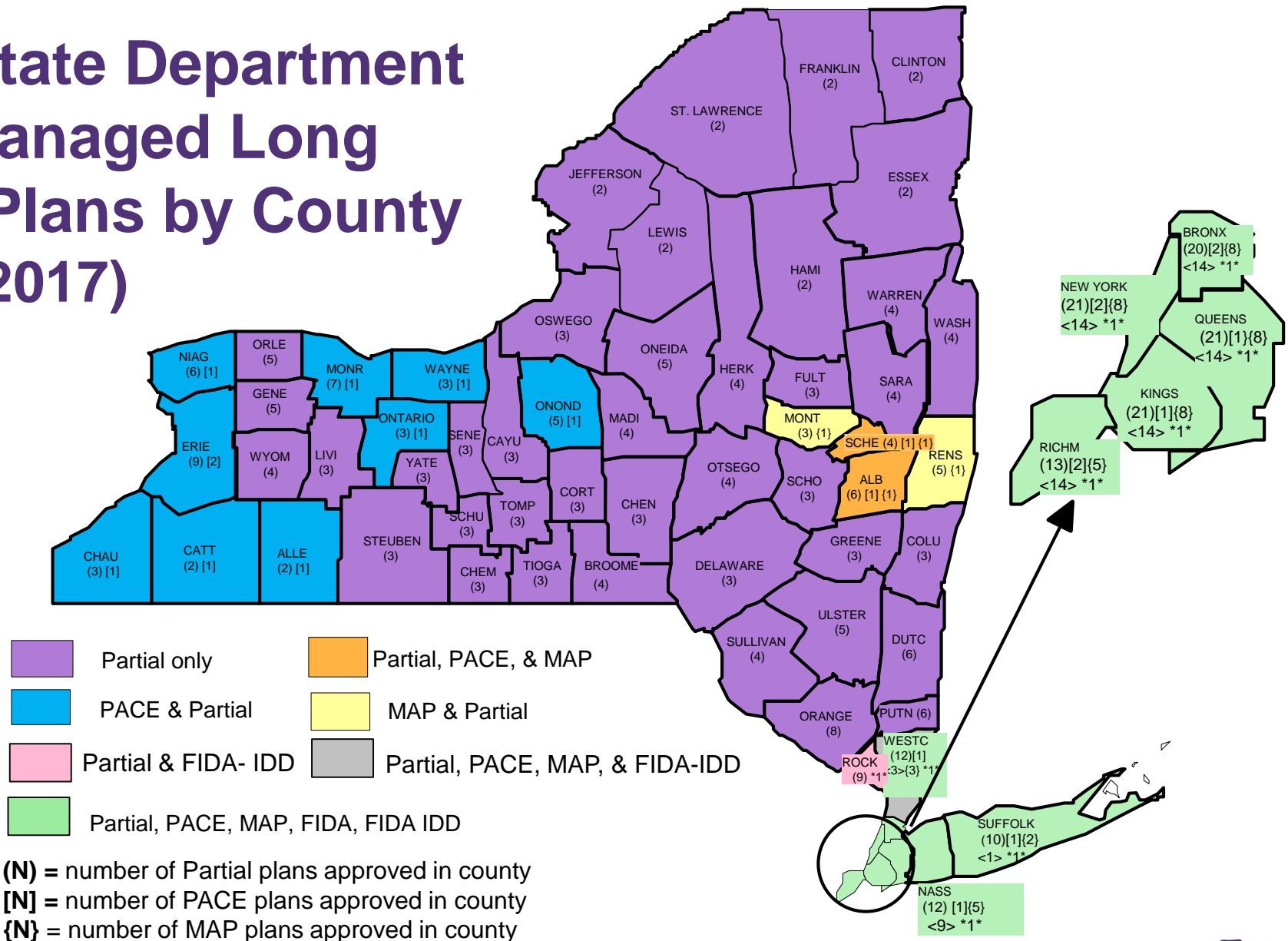

Geographic Scope

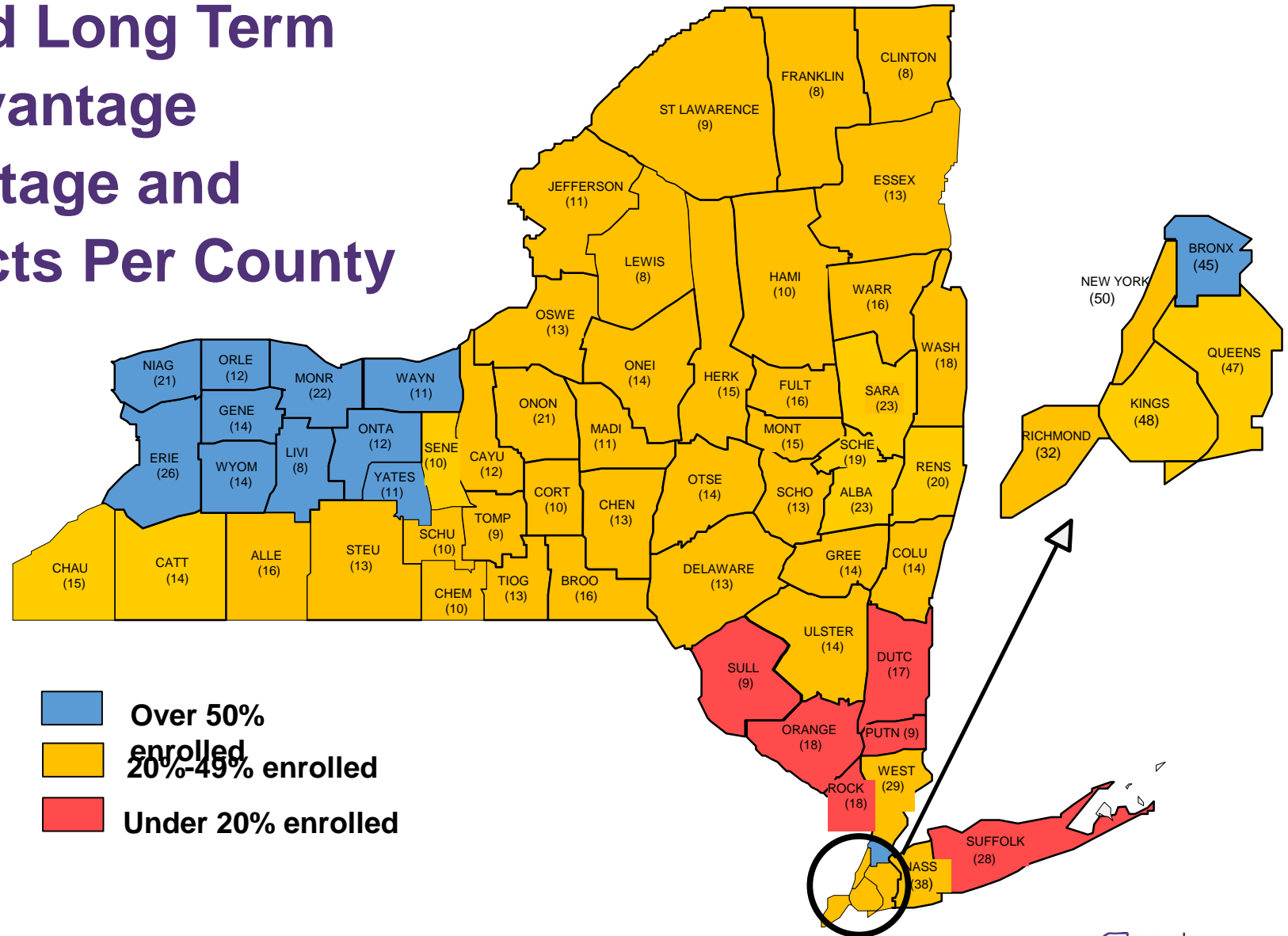
- Current landscape

Geographic Scope

- Which geographic areas should be included?

 - If not, what timelines?
- What preparatory steps are necessary to build for 2020 in all geographic areas?

Platform for Integrating with Medicare

- Should the State request permission to continue using the MMP demonstration authority (FIDA Platform) to build the FOIC program?
- Should the State pursue additional demonstration authority for the FOIC program?
- Should the State use a D-SNP or FIDE-SNP plus Medicaid Plan model?
- What are the considerations and timelines for each?

Consolidation of Existing Programs

- What consolidation of existing programs should we consider?
- Should any programs be maintained exactly as they are?
 - If so, which programs?
- How many integrated programs should there be?

Considerations for Transition

- What transition process and protections need to be incorporated?
- How will we move consumers to the new model?
- How do we ensure seamless transition?
- What do you want the State to make sure we consider about transition as DOH is planning for the program?
